MEASURING SVP IMPACT

Social Venture Partners are changing the way Austin gives back. Over a four year period, SVPs influenced **over three million dollars** in funds committed to nonprofits.

IMPACT IN ACTION

Allies Against Slavery, one of our most recent partner nonprofits, uses technology, data, and partnerships to combat human trafficking and protect freedom and dignity. With SVP support, Allies developed and launched Lighthouse, an online screening tool used to identify victims. SVPs also helped Allies revamp their marketing, design a new website, and develop a strategic growth plan and business model. In one year, Allies tripled the number of victims identified.

SVPs provided **strategic guidance, set goals, and served as mentors.** We're continuing our work with Allies to strengthen their sales and marketing strategy, and enhance Lighthouse.

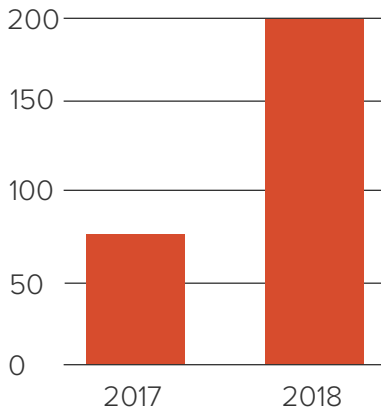
